Fun tidbits about our building.....

- It was originally the First National Bank of Oak Park - but only from 1919 – 1930 - it was a bad time to open a bank. (It was then a funeral home in the 1950's and most recently a credit card processing center). Yes, this building turns 100 years old as we open.

- The beautiful bar top and tables were made for us by Tom Kunkel from Urban Pioneer Group in Forest Park. The material used is the heart pine subfloor repurposed from Ford Motor Company's first showroom outside Detroit which was previously located at South Michigan Avenue and Cermak Ave.

- The two-story chandelier (or chandelbeer as we like to call it!) was made for us by local artist Jeff Filo, who was president of the Oak Park Homebrewer's club at the time.

**Any guess as to how many bottles are in it?**

- On the edge of the main bar there is an old beer bottle from McAvoy brewing company, one of Chicago's largest breweries before Prohibition. The date on the bottle is 1919 which is the same year the bank was built.

- If you happen to use the restrooms on any floor, the doors are from the old Molly Malone's Irish Pub in Forest Park. We love that what is old is new again; and a little luck from the Irish never hurts

- On the second floor all of the architectural details are original to the building. You can still feel what it would have been like to stand in the bank over a hundred years ago.

- Our friend, Frank Lipo from the Oak Park Historical Society, has graciously loaned us some beautiful photos from 1923 of the streets of Oak Park.

- When you are on the roof top and look East you can just make out a little of the Chicago skyline, but mostly trees. We like the trees. (There is also a reclaimed red arrow that points to the perfect spot to take a selfie! ) Tag us **@onelakebrewing**
